ADRIA VINI

The mainstay of white wine production is pinot Grigio, sourced from the Pavia region, south of Milan, and the Veneto. The reds come from mature, low yielding vineyards in southern Italy (mainly Puglia and Abruzzo), the source of some of Europe's most undervalued and characterful wines.

AZIENDA AGRICOLA LA BATTISTINA

Araldica's La Battistina estate consists of 25 hectares of south facing vineyards, including 5 hectares of 'Gavi del Comune di Gavi', on a unique combination of limestone and clay. The estate is divided into distinct areas producing very different wines. 'Nuovo Quadro' comes from a small plot at the foot of the Battistina hill which lies within the Gavi di Gavi sub-zone.

ARALDICA, PIEMONTE

Araldica is Piemonte's largest and most progressive co-operative yet retains a small, family run company feel. 80% of production is bottled at the company's headquarters in the Monferrato hills, home of the old cellars and a new winery, operating since September 2000. This is complimented by two estates, each with its own vinification cellars, Il Cascinone and La Battistina in Gavi.

IL CASCINONE, PIEMONTE

This exceptional estate in the Monferrato hills was bought by Araldica in 1999. The warmer, southwest facing slopes are used to grow gratifyingly challenging Barbera while those facing northeast give fresher growing conditions, ideal for aromatic varieties such as Brachetto and Sauvignon Blanc.

Lapostolle is owned by the Marnier-Lapostolle family (of Grand Marnier fame), and since the winery's foundation in 1994 has pursued an uncompromising approach to quality. Their objective is simple as it is ambitious: to create world-class wines using French expertise and the superb terroir of Chile.
